And she sat (03427 +yashab) beside (06654 +tsad) the reapers (07114 +qatsar):and he reached (06642 +tsabat) her {parched} (07039 +qaliy) [corn] , and she did eat (00398 +)akal) , and was sufficed (07646 +saba() , and left (03498 +yathar) .
